1) Land Use Administrator-given by Dan Prunuske – 12 permits - \$820,000 construction total; \$4.4 million total for year

2) Planning Committee-given by Dan Prunuske - approved letter of intent for Derek Gensch for 5 acres off of farm house; Derek to farm and likely sell off buildings; 6th Gear approved to be moved to residential; campers were brought up, Beaver Plumbing requested 5 campers on property for data center, certificate of zoning approved for 5 campers, Beaver Plumbing is no asking for 10, committee tabled at the meeting, looking for board suggestions

3) Board of Appeals-given by Dan Prunuske - no meeting
